It is important to note that cultural diplomacy depends on three important points. Secondly, the economic aspect, which is one of the forms of mutual cooperation between countries, and this support casts its shadow on their relations with each other. Thirdly, the political dimension, which deals with political relations between countries and means of strengthening relations or resolving conflicts, if any.

On the other hand, the corridors of Saudi politics has been a witness of many Saudi diplomats who are known for their rich cultural knowledge and their practice of one of the types of arts. It helps to educate intellectuals and writers in leadership positions to enrich the culture of peace and dialogue. Therefore, it is necessary for countries to set up centers that aims at practicing public diplomacy, and achieving their missions, which includes activating the role of cultural diplomacy and contributing to the activation of foreign policy through cooperation with organizations and bodies of friendly countries, to end up with a joint cooperation in related issues.

As a result, the Kingdom has made significant efforts to support international cultural bodies and organizations and to participate in the World Arabic Language Day (WALD), also known as the UN Arabic Language Day. Also, supporting and the funding of foreign universities that teach the Arabic language, and the establishing of a number of chairs in them to support Arabic language and Islamic studies. In addition to the allocation of a number of Saudi International Awards to support translations.

When talking about international efforts to support Saudi cultural diplomacy, it is crucial to mention the important role played by the cultural attachés. It participates in international book fairs and cultural seminars as part of its role in spreading and introducing the Saudi culture internationally. Some also hold a monthly cultural salon to achieve cultural and knowledge communication that aims at increasing convergence and dialogue between cultures and followers of other religions. In addition to the implementation and holding of cultural weeks that accompany official visits at the level of leaders. These practices illustrate the importance of culture as a crucial part of political and diplomatic work among nations, contribute the expansion of bridges of communication and cooperation between governments, and promote convergence and dialogue among people.




